How do we support Children to attend school?

1. We monitor children's attendance closely and, if a child's attendance is not at the expectation, we will contact you to offer support.

2. Offer Wellbeing Coffee Mornings where parents and carers can seek support and guidance.

3. We offer support through our pastoral teams.
